How Parents Can Support Your Children?

- ✓ Create a conducive learning environment at home

- ✓ Use dark blue/black ballpoint pen only;
- Create awareness in children, by <u>having conversations with</u> them on <u>issues</u> that impact Singapore and around the world eg. Online gaming etc.
