Engaging For Learning

Students' perception of the extent to which their teachers are able to engage and motivate them to learn.

Academic Self-Efficacy

Students' sense of confidence and competence in academic work.

Growth Mindset

The extent to which students believe that their ability and intelligence can develop and grow over time.

Strategies by the school in 2024

Structuring after school schedule to reduce clashes

2023: CCAs on either Tuesday and Thursday, or Wednesday and Friday, which often clashed with subject enrichment.


Student Leadership to be given a stipulated time to conduct training which grows our students holistically.

Strategies by the school in 2024

Support our teachers who have been working with overlapping schedules and provide time for their development.

To balance student wellbeing, teacher wellbeing and development, school bus availability and coach/instructor availability.

Academic Support

Guidelines on Daily Homework

Levels	Weekly Homework Time (estimated)
P1 and P2	2 - 4 hours
P3 and P4	5 – 7 hours
P5 and P6	8 – 10 hours

Note:

- Lower Primary students complete most of their work in class.
- Upper Primary students need more time to complete practice papers.

Academic Support

- Homework policy: balancing between school and other types of homework.
- Timely intervention: Parent-Teacher-Student Conference in March with the opportunity to meet subject teachers (by appointment in Term 1 Week 10).
- Timed oral practice in May.

Growing the Supportive Factors




- P6 Synergy Camp in March: for showing support and commitment to goals → End of Term 1
- Focused-Group Discussion (FGD) for P6s to lend more targetted support.

Providing Relevant and Timely Information


- DSA Briefing in April with sharing by alumni and other relevant sessions for parents and students.

- Regular check-ins by Form Teachers.



Who matters in this equation?




Term 1 Check-in Survey (2024)
