

# Mother Tongue School-Based Oracy Training

## Adopt-A-Kid

In our effort to provide continual support in the area of oracy for Mother Tongue Languages, the Mother Tongue department runs a programme called Adopt-A-Kid.

In classes operating on a manageable teacher-student ratio, selected students requiring additional assistance are given scaffolded guidance in the areas of reading aloud as well as oral conversation. In doing so, we aim to build your child's confidence as he/ she copes with both the school and national Mother Tongue oral assessments.

A structure was drawn to systematically train these students on Reading & Conversation Skills. Reading skills, such as using Appropriate Volume, Correct Pronunciation, Fluency and Pausing between sentence & within sentence as well as Expression will be taught. Students will also be trained to identify the Theme/Values of videos & expand their answers to the 3 conversation questions in the E-Oral examination. With the small class size, these students will have more opportunities to practice on the different skills taught and teachers can provide personalized guidance to them.
