Classroom Routines/Procedures

- is able to **manage the daily challenges** of school life

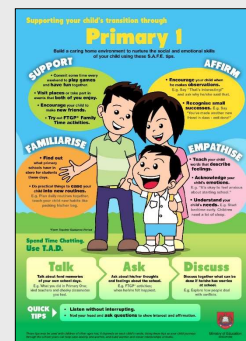
HOW CAN PARENTS SUPPORT YOUR CHILD ?
