P1 pupils are dismissed <u>10 minutes earlier</u> than the official dismissal timings stated above due to Safe Management Measures (SMMs).



School Traffic Management Plan

Objective

To be familiar with our Traffic Management Plan and guidelines that have been put in place to ensure:

- ➤ Safety of pupils and staff within the school and immediate vicinity outside the school.
- ➤ Smooth traffic flow and prevent traffic congestion during peak periods especially during arrival and dismissal times.

Constraints

- ▶ Limited parking lots inside the school
- ► Large number of school buses 25 school buses
- Narrow roads outside the school
- ► Roads are heavily used by public bus service (173), nearby residents and other road users

Arrival

- ► All vehicles are to enter via Entrance Gate and leave via Exit Gate. Passengers are to alight at foyer outside General Office (stop-drop-go).
- ► All vehicles are to **turn left** upon exiting.
- ► All pedestrians are to use **Pedestrian Gate**.
- ▶ All to follow the instructions of staff on duty.
- ▶ Parking of vehicles within the school premises is strictly not allowed.

Dismissal

- ≥ 25 school buses
- ▶ Pupils taking school buses will assemble in the school hall.
- Sequence of dismissal:
 - ▶ P1 & P2 pupils taking private transport are dismissed first (led by teachers).
 - ► Followed by pupils from other levels taking private transport.
 - Lastly, pupils taking school buses are dismissed.
