

BTPS Inspire is a school-wide initiative that provides opportunities for cross level interactions and learning for all pupils. This year, BTPS Inspire tapped on the theme of SG Bicentennial and commemorated National Day. Level-wide projects and performances formed part of the week-long National Day celebrations. Through level-wide learning activities, pupils shared what they have learnt about Singapore's 200 years of history through interesting mediums such visual arts, poetry and virtual reality. Pupils rose to the occasion and demonstrated the character strengths - *Love of Learning & Teamwork*. Through BTPS Inspire, pupils' collective efforts forged a stronger sense of belonging to our nation.

The character strengths of Love of learning and Teamwork were evident as pupils strived for the best and guided each other in their pursuit of interests. Pupils gained confidence and put up a showcase or exhibition of what they had learnt. In certain levels, pupils also taught their newly learned skills and knowledge with their juniors; leading to a meaningful interaction and friendship. It was a week of learning - full of inspiring Singapore stories. For instance, P2 pupils taught P1 pupils the skill of mosaic tiling and shared what they have learnt about Singapore icons while P3 pupils presented the 200-year history of Singapore through a drama performance while all P6 pupils synchronized their individual drumming for a heart-thumping performance.

We believe that these learning experiences would remind our pupils of how Singapore's forefathers too, have worked hard together to achieve a common goal.
