HOW WILL I BE NOTIFIED?

Students will be informed of Live Lessons using Zoom or Google Meet in advance through SLS announcement or lessons.

WHAT SHOULD I DO IF I AM LATE OR HAVE MISSED THE LESSON?

If you have missed the Live Lesson, email your subject teacher to share the reason.

Your teacher will support you accordingly.

Before you begin the Live Lesson

- 1. Put on the PE T-shirt and ensure that your hair is tidy.
- 2. Be away from family activities so as to reduce noise distraction.
- Ensure that the room has good lighting.
- 4. Be seated on a chair with your laptop on the desk. No slouching on sofa or placing laptop on your lap or stomach
- 5. Test your headphones, microphone, and camera to make sure the class can hear and see you.



Ground rules for Live Lessons

Behave in the same manner as in a face-to-face classroom interaction

- Be punctual
- 2. Be respectful
 - Keep your microphone muted
 - To speak, raise your hand (in Zoom) and wait for the teacher before unmuting your microphone
 - Look at the screen to show you are being attentive
 - Participate actively during the lesson
 - Use the toilet before the start of the session to minimise movement

From time to time, smile and nod to show the speaker that you are listening. ©


If your classmate is sharing something good, give a thumbs up!
