


Overview of MT T&L

Teaching & Learning of MT

- Questioning Technique to elicit responses
- TR to engage students- explore, connect ideas, and delve deeper Reading & Oral Communication Skill
- Developing students' reading skills according to the 6 levels of Reading comprehension Processes
- Comprehensive Oral Resources to help develop pupils' oracy skills.
 Writing Skill
- Writing Package to develop pupils' writing skills (Progressive)
- Journaling to develop writing skills (TR)
- Making Learning Interesting and Interactive
- Role Playing, Games, Interactive Conversation
- After School Remediation Program
- Skill-based Focus (for selected pupils with concern)



Overview of MT T&L- 6 levels of Reading Comprehension Process



Creatively solve problem based on the text

Judgement of text based Cause-Effect/ Fact and opinion

Infer and predicts using facts from text

Organizing the flow of the- passage/ Understand casual sentences/ Compare & contrast

Explaining in own words/ Understanding the big ideas and themes from text

Paraphrasing/Finding facts/Basic understanding of the passage



Partnering Parents to support pupils' learning

Create an environment conducive for learning MT

- Structured time for MT revision and learning at home
- Discuss topics/newspaper articles/news so that they can build up their confidence to speak the language
- Guide them to express their views
- Read to them. Read with your child. Listen to them read. (Use Supplementary Reading Materials/ textbooks / Story Books)
