- ✓ Check child's work regularly: Homework; quality of work; handwriting; Be there physically with them if possible.
- ✓ Emphasise on neat / legible handwriting (On-screen marking)
- ✓ Use dark blue/black ballpoint pen only;
- ✓ Give extra care to both written and spoken language of our children.
